Road resurfacing and maintenance works

We are undertaking road resurfacing works along the Old Sturt Highway. These works form part of our ongoing program of road maintenance across the State.

What's happening:

Road resurfacing involves laying new asphalt or other materials on top of the existing road surface to repair damage, create a smoother drive, and improve safety for all drivers.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, we will have speed and lane restrictions in work areas. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. Old Sturt Highway will remain open at all times with speed restrictions still in place outside of work hours.

There will be no impact to traffic on the Sturt Highway.
