

Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

Roundabout upgrades, Mount Gambier

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users. The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

Heavy Vehicle Detour

Works on Jubilee Highway West (Princes Highway) within the township of Mount Gambier are nearing completion. **Due to conflicting works being delivered by another agency, a change to the current heavy vehicle detour is now required.**

How this affects you

From Wednesday 1 May 2024, heavy vehicles are required to detour via Wandilo Road, Pine Hall Avenue and Penola Road (Riddoch Highway). Please see detour map overleaf.

Heavy vehicle drivers are asked to please plan ahead to allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

It is expected that this detour will remain in place until all program works in the Mount Gambier township are completed, which is expected in late June 2024.
