

# Asphalt Maintenance Works

## Hampstead Road Night Works – Rescheduled

### What's happening:

General maintenance activities, including asphalt patching, are required at multiple locations to improve the road surface.

### How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Speed and lane restrictions will be required while works are underway. Speed restrictions may be required until line marking is fully complete which is expected by early February 2024, weather permitting.

### Heavy vehicle

Heavy vehicle access to Hampstead Road via Taunton Avenue will be restricted during the works. Heavy vehicles to detour via Sudholz Road and Grand Junction Road.

Pedestrians and cyclists might also need to use a different path during the works; however, signs will show you where to go.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

A few bus stops in the area might be affected for a short time. Please pay attention to the signs at the bus stops and check the latest updates at [adelaidemetro.com.au](https://www.adelaidemetro.com.au) for more information.
