

North East Road and Reservoir Road Intersection Upgrade

Mast Arm Installation – night works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is undertaking key safety upgrades at the intersection of North East Road and Reservoir Road at Modbury. This project is funded by the Australian Government's Black Spot Program, which provides funding for road safety initiatives.

Works include:

- upgrade of the existing standard traffic light poles to mast arm poles to increase visibility and sight distances for approaching traffic;
- installation of Tactile Ground Surface Indicators to assist people who are blind or vision-impaired with warning or directional orientation information; and
- upgrade of the northern pedestrian islands and new line marking.

What to expect

Works are scheduled to commence on Sunday, 22 October and are expected to be completed early December 2023 (weather permitting). Works will be undertaken Sunday to Thursday. To minimise disruption to the community **works will be undertaken at night, between the hours of 7pm and 6am.**

To safely facilitate these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during working hours, with speed restrictions remaining in place for the duration of works, including outside of working hours.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling throughout the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. When required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Road users are asked to please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
