

Safety Barrier Installation

Onkaparinga Valley Road, between Verdun and Woodside

What's happening:

As part of the Adelaide Hills Road Safety Program, we are installing safety barriers at multiple locations along Onkaparinga Valley Road, between Woodside and Verdun to improve safety for all road users.

How this affects you:

Works will move progressively along Onkaparinga Valley Road, see locations map overleaf.

To do this work safely, Onkaparinga Valley Road will be reduced to a single lane with temporary traffic signals in place to control the direction of traffic where required. Speed restrictions will be in place throughout the work areas.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. Onkaparinga Valley Road will remain open at all times.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.

We will maintain access to properties throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
