

Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

Renmark to Gawler

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$87.5 million (80:20) to upgrade the Sturt Highway, between Renmark and Gawler, as part of the Roads of Strategic Importance program.

As part of this program, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport will be constructing a new eastbound overtaking lane east of Truro, between Stonefield Road and Liebigs Road, Steinfeld.

What to expect

Works on the new overtaking lane are **expected to commence on Monday, 21 August 2023** and are scheduled to be completed in February 2024 (weather permitting). Works will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between 6am and 6pm. Some Sunday work may be required.

The Sturt Highway will remain open to traffic at all times. To safely facilitate these works speed and lane restrictions will be required during works. Outside of work hours, speed and lane restrictions will remain in place throughout the work area.

Access to Stonefield Road and Swamp Road will be maintained during the works, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict access to these side roads.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.
