

River Murray Flood Recovery Works

Angas Valley Road, Walker Flat

We are undertaking flood recovery works on Angas Valley Road, Walker Flat. These works form part of a \$60 million plan funded by the State Government to repair roads impacted by the River Murray floods.

What's happening:

Works include pavement sealing and shoulder repairs on the section of Angas Valley Road affected by the River Murray flooding.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Traffic will be intermittently reduced to a single lane, with traffic controllers in place to control the direction of traffic. Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will need to remain in place, until completion.

During the works, there may be some noise and dust from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to restrict driveway access temporarily.

Access to the Walker Flat ferry will be unaffected by these works.
