Annual Dinner & Conference (Saturday 3rd August 2024, Adelaide Convention Centre)

The major sponsorship exposure event is our renowned SARTA Dinner & Conference. The 2024 event will be held at the Adelaide Convention Centre on **Saturday 3rd August**. The sponsorship exposure and benefits associated with this event are:

Dinner Seats

Foundation sponsors receive 10 complimentary dinner seats, **Gold sponsors** receive 6.

Product Displays

Foundation & Gold sponsors are allocated floor space for a display in the Dinner Hall – eg. one truck or trailer. (Multiple brand Foundation sponsors have one space per brand as arranged with SARTA).

In addition, our layout enables us to offer **Foundation Sponsors** the option of also displaying a Vehicle in the Conference Room which is adjacent to the main dinner hall.

This will mean that if they wish, **Foundation Truck Sponsors** will be able to have a rig in BOTH the Conference Hall and in the Dinner Hall. The displays in the Conference Hall will be exposed to the conference delegates as well as approx. 600 dinner guests.

Other **Gold** and **Foundation sponsors** may elect to have a display booth within the Conference Hall- and will just have to pay the cost of the booth; which is normally only a few hundred dollars. As well as being popular, they are also limited – please indicate your interest in a booth early to avoid missing out.

Dinner PowerPoint also includes up to 6 personalised slides from each **Foundation Sponsor**, and 3 from **Gold Sponsors**.
