

Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

Intersection upgrade

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve safety and traffic efficiency for road users. The upgrades are funded through the \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor Program, jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian Government (20%).

What's happening:

We are upgrading the Princes Highway intersection with The Springs Road and Burrungule Road to improve road quality and safety.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, we will have speed and lane restrictions in work areas. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs.

The Princes Highway will remain open at all times with speed restrictions still in place outside of work hours. Temporary speed limits apply to all road users in the work area, even when workers are not on-site.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however we will minimise disturbance, as much as practically possible. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

No works will be undertaken between Friday, 22 December 2023 and Sunday, 7 January 2024.
