

Princes Highway Corridor Upgrades

Walkers Tin Hut Road – Works Update

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users. The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

Pavement works at the junction of Walkers Tin Hut Road are now underway. **To safely facilitate works at the junction, access to Walkers Tin Hut Road is now closed with a detour in place, this detour will now remain in place until Wednesday 24 January 2024.**

How this affects you

Works commenced on Monday, 8 January 2024. During these works there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe.

Traffic on Princes Highway will be reduced to a single lane with onsite traffic controllers to control the direction of traffic. Outside of work hours traffic will be reopened to two lanes with speed restrictions in place.

Access to Walkers Tin Hut Road (from Princes Highway) will remain closed outside of work hours, with access via Emerald Road. Please see detour map overleaf.

Following completion of the pavement works, speed restrictions will remain in place until line marking is fully completed. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

No works will be undertaken on Friday 26 January 2024 due to the public holiday. Project completion at this location is expected in early February 2024, weather permitting.

The Bells Road and Princes Highway junction closure (previously scheduled for Monday 22 January 2024) will commence following completion of the Walkers Tin Hut Road closure. Information about this closure is available on the project website.
