

Road Resurfacing

Grand Junction Road, Main North Road, Port Wakefield Road intersection

We will be undertaking road resurfacing works on Grand Junction Road, across the Main North Road and Port Wakefield Road intersection. These works, that will occur between Amanga Street and Florence Avenue, will improve the safety and amenity of the road for all users.

What's happening:

Works are expected to **commence Thursday, 30 November 2023**.

The old and deteriorated asphalt on the road surface will be removed and a fresh layer of asphalt will be applied in its place. This project is necessary to ensure the road remains in good condition as wear and tear can cause potholes and uneven surfaces over time. Road resurfacing will result in a smoother and safer driving experience for all road users.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions at different times to keep everyone safe.

Between 8pm and 5am on Saturday, 2 December 2023, Sunday, 3 December 2023 and Monday, 4 December 2023 the intersection will be closed at night to north/south traffic on Main North Road and Port Wakefield Road. A detour will be in place via Cavan Road and Grand Junction Road (see map overleaf) from **8pm to 5am**.

Outside of these dates, during working hours, the intersection will be open to traffic, with one lane open in each direction.

Outside of working hours, all lanes will open to traffic in each direction with some speed restrictions in place.

When

Thursday, 30 November 2023 for approximately one week.

between 8pm and 5am

Where

Grand Junction Road, between Amanga Street and Florence Avenue, including the intersection with Main North Road and Port Wakefield Road.
