

Asphalt Maintenance Works

Kensington Road Night Works

What's happening:

Asphalt patching works are required at multiple locations along Kensington Road between Penfold Road and Portrush Road, Kensington, to improve the road surface. The asphaltting works will move progressively along Kensington Road.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Speed and lane restrictions will be required while works are underway. Some local detours may be required, please follow onsite signage.

Speed restrictions will remain in place until line marking is fully completed, which is expected by mid-April 2024, weather permitting.

Pedestrians and cyclists might also need to use a different path during the works. Signs will be in place to show you where to go.

During the works, there will be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

Some property access may be temporarily impacted during the night works, but we will do our best to maintain access to businesses in the area. The project team will contact affected property owners, residents, and businesses directly in advance.
