

Asphalt Maintenance Works

Henley Beach Road Night Works

What's happening:

General maintenance activities, including asphalt patching, are required at multiple locations to remediate sections of the road and improve the road surface.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Speed and lane restrictions will be required while works are underway.

Speed restrictions will be required until line marking is fully complete which is expected by early April 2024, weather permitting.

Pedestrians and cyclists might need to use a different path during the works. Signs will show you where to go.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

A few bus stops in the area might be affected for a short time. Please pay attention to the signs at the bus stops and check the latest updates at adelaidemetro.com.au for more information.

Some property access will be temporarily impacted during the night works, but we will do our best to maintain access to businesses in the area. The project team will contact affected property owners, residents, and businesses directly in advance.
