# River Torrens to Darlington

## Advance Notice – Cross Road & South Road Resurfacing

**Resurfacing works at the intersection of South Road and Cross Road are required and will tie into the recently completed works between Bennet Avenue, Melrose Park and Glengarry Avenue, Glandore.** The works involve removing the existing pavement and replacing it with new asphalt. This work will ensure the long-term safety and integrity of these sections ahead of the start of major T2D project works.

To reduce impacts to community, these resurfacing works have been scheduled during the planned temporary closure of the Seaford Railway Line in January 2024 for essential maintenance work. ### Timing and Traffic Impacts

**From 9pm Thursday 25 January 2024 until 5am Monday 29 January 2024 the intersection of Cross Road and South Road (under the overpass) will be closed to all traffic. This includes all on and off ramp from South Road and Cross Road. Works will be undertaken continuously throughout the closure period.**

**Light and heavy vehicle detours will be in place throughout this four-day period.** Please see overleaf for detour maps.

Some properties on South Road and Cross Road in close proximity to the intersection may have some restricted access. The project team will contact affected property owners, residents and businesses directly in advance. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with access where required. Some local side streets may have increased traffic during the four-day period.

From Monday 29 January 2024 speed restrictions will remain in place until line marking is completed over the coming weeks.

### What to expect

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours where required.

Some Adelaide Metro bus services and bus stops, within the project area, may be temporarily impacted while work is underway, please observe bus stop signage and visit [www.adelaidemetro.com.au](http://www.adelaidemetro.com.au) for the latest information.
