

Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

Works Update

We are constructing a new eastbound overtaking lane east of Truro, between Stonefield Road and Liebigs Road, Steinfeld. The \$87.5 million Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

Works on the new overtaking lane between Stonefield Road and Liebigs Road, Steinfeld, are continuing. Previous notices advised that work was scheduled to be completed by February 2024. However, weather impacts, and the availability of materials mean that works are now expected to be completed in early May 2024.

How this affects you:

The Sturt Highway will remain open to traffic at all times. To safely facilitate these works speed and lane restrictions will be required during works. Outside of work hours, speed and lane restrictions will remain in place as required throughout the work area.

No works will be undertaken across the Easter long weekend.

Access to Stonefield Road and Swamp Road will continue to be maintained during the works, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict access to these side roads. We appreciate your cooperation and patience while these important works continue.
