

# Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

## Roundabout Upgrades, Mount Gambier

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering infrastructure upgrades on the Princes Highway, from Tantanoola to the South Australian/Victorian border. The project forms part of the \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade program, which is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20).

As part of the program, the Department is upgrading four roundabouts on the Jubilee Highway West (Princes Highway) at O'Leary Road, Suttontown Road, Wehl Street North and Penola Road (Riddoch Highway) in the township of Mount Gambier. The works also include road pavement rehabilitation to improve safety and traffic efficiency along the Princes Highway.

### What to expect

Works within the township of Mount Gambier will commence at the O'Leary Road roundabout, from Monday, 4 September 2023 with completion at this roundabout expected in mid-October 2023 (weather permitting). Works will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 5pm. Some work outside of these times may be required with advance notice provided.

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be required in the vicinity of the O'Leary Road roundabout. Please plan ahead to allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained at all times during the works.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

### Heavy vehicles

**A detour for heavy vehicles will be in place via Tollner Road, White Avenue and Sutton Avenue. This will remain in place for the duration of the works at this location. Please refer to map overleaf.**

Roundabout upgrades at the other locations will be undertaken progressively to minimise disruption to traffic. Community will be provided advance notice prior to works commencing at the other locations.
