

# River Murray Flood Recovery Works

## Bookpurnong Road, Kingston

We are undertaking flood recovery works on Bookpurnong Road between Gurra Road and Kemp Road, south of Berri. It's part of a \$60 million plan funded by the State Government to repair roads impacted by the River Murray floods.

### What's happening:

The project involves fixing up the sides of the road and repairing the road surface following the River Murray flooding in late 2022/early 2023.

### How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Traffic will be intermittently reduced to a single lane with temporary traffic signals in place to control the direction of traffic. Outside of working hours, the road will re-open to traffic in each direction with some speed restrictions in place.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work. We appreciate your cooperation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
